These positions will be decided **the week before each event** and each officer will be assigned an email address and password. Candidates deemed most worthy by our staff of experts (and their parole officers) will be notified by the Sheriff's Dept. (that shouldn't be unusual) or by email/phone. Maps and missions will be sent to all the officers and the officers can then plan strategies with their respective generals. Or not.

General:

If selected, each General will receive free admission, a pair of Extreme Rage Thermal goggles with fan, free lunch and case of paint

Company Commander:

If selected, each Commander will receive 1000 paintballs, a free lunch.

Medic:

If selected, each Medic will receive 500 paintballs upon evaluation by a commander.

- Using proper field etiquette (like, "Get Out, Get OUT" Squid Boy, please").
- Completing necessary training requirements (reading the rules? What?)
- Following company policies and procedures (keep my goggles on? During the game?)
- Following directions (this could be asking too much for paintball players)

Maintaining a professional appearance and complying with the company dress code (I think this is pretty obvious. P I M P or go home!)
